The Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor (D&L) is both a diverse, multi-faceted organization, and a multi-use trail spanning 165 miles from the mountains of northeast Pennsylvania through the Lehigh Valley and Bucks County.

The D&L is a true public-private partnership. Passionate residents and volunteers work alongside local, regional, and national entities to conserve cultural and natural resources in the five-county region of eastern Pennsylvania. This is a nationally significant historic transportation route that traverses railroads, canals, rivers and trails.

Since 1988, when Congress established the Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor, we have worked diligently to preserve and revitalize historic places and landmark towns, conserve green space for public use, document and interpret our heritage, celebrate our community and region, and create partnerships and programs for long-term sustainability.

Details

- Packet Pick-up is located in Northern Lehigh High School on Saturday from 10 AM to 3 PM or Sunday from 6 AM to 7:15 AM

- Before starting the race, take your bag to the bag check truck where your bag will be tagged for pick-up after the race.

- Spectators should use the route indicated in gray. Road conditions change on race day and this is the best route to the finishing area.

- Please DO NOT park on private property or block any roads. Respect FOR and support of LOCAL residents is essential to the successful planning of this race.

Details

- After crossing the finish line, pick up your medal and water, claim your bag, use the bathrooms and changing tents, and continue to the Hungarian Hall with your bib for food and awards.

- Runner awards take place at 10:30 AM

- Walker awards take place at 12:00 PM

- Race participants are provided with free bus transportation back to the Starting Area between 10 AM and 1 PM. Buses will leave from Hungarian Hall.

- Canal Street north of Fourteenth Street is closed except to local residents on the day of the race.
