Four fantastic races Three cities One incredibly inspirational day



Marathon racing returns to the Lehigh Valley with the St. Luke's D&L RaceFest on November 12, 2023.

As the region's most prolific day of racing, St. Luke's D&L RaceFest expects over 2,000 participants in its inaugural year with expectations to grow in 2024 and beyond to 3,000 participants or more.

Now produced by the Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor (DLNHC), the event taps the legacy of distance running established by Via, which offered its final events in partnership with St. Luke's in 2019.

The St. Luke's D&L RaceFest includes four events:

- The St. Luke's D&L Marathon, "The Lehigh Valley's Marathon," which will cover a USTAF-certified, Boston-qualifying 26.2-mile course from downtown Allentown to downtown Easton, a majority of which follows the mostly flat and net downhill D&L Trail along the Lehigh River.
- St. Luke's D&L Marathon Relay, the region's only marathon relay, which will cover the same course as the full marathon as a five-person team with legs ranging about 4 miles to 7 miles.

- The D&L Heritage Half Marathon, presented by St. Luke's. The 13.1-mile Run or Walk will both start in historic downtown Bethlehem and follow the D&L Trail to Easton. It is one of the only half marathons in the region with a dedicated walking category with awards. This half marathon is a continuation of DLNHC's previous event and will be its 12th annual half marathon.

All races will end with a post-race party in downtown Easton!

 (although Marathon Relay participants can be as young as 10 y.o.)
- Gender: Approximately 40% male, 60% female as well as non-binary participants
- Income: \$50,000-\$150,000+
- Education: Majority college-educated or higher
- Interests: Fitness, outdoor recreation, health and wellness, philanthropy, community engagement
- Geography: Our marathon attracts a diverse audience from the Lehigh Valley and beyond.
 - Nearly 60% of will come from the Lehigh Valley.
 - 25% travel locally from Northeastern PA, Philadelphia metro region or New Jersey
 - 15% will come from across the U.S.
